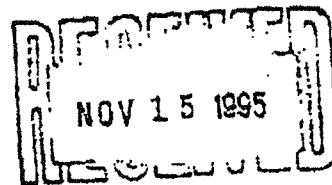

Under the authority of Section 21315 of Part 213 Leaking Underground Storage Tanks (LUST) of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended (Act 451), the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ), Underground Storage Tank Division (USTD), has conducted an audit of the corrective actions undertaken by _____ Qualified Underground Storage Tank Consultant (QC) as the result of a release from an underground storage tank system at the subject site. The audit consisted of a review of district file documents including the October 30, 1995 Closure Report Addendum.

Based on this audit, the USTD agrees with the conclusion by the QC that corrective action at the site has resulted in UNRESTRICTED RESIDENTIAL USE of the site based on a Tier 1 evaluation.

Please note that when contaminated soil and/or groundwater as a result of a release of a regulated substance remains on site consistent with site closure requirements, the owner/operator shall not remove soil and/or groundwater, or allow soil and/or groundwater to be removed from the site to an off-site location without properly characterizing the soils and/or groundwater to determine that the soils and/or groundwater can be lawfully relocated without posing a threat to the public health safety, or welfare, or the environment. The determination shall consider whether the soil and/or groundwater is subject to regulations under Part 111 of Act 451.


