

CASE HISTORY 4/94 TO 12/94

SITE LOCATION: Michigan      TARGET CONTAMINANTS: BTEX in groundwater

Lambda Bioremediation Systems, Inc. was contracted by a company to bring their ground water to MDNR level 2 compliance. The company had removed their underground fuel storage tank in 1991 and found soil and ground water contamination.

Lambda transported and injected 5,000 gallons of acclimated microbes to the site on 08/11/94. Trenches and injection points were used to access the site. 6 month monitoring event took place in February, 1995. At that time 6 of the 12 monitoring wells were in compliance.
